A GOODBYE AND TIME TO LOOK AHEAD

As many of you will know, this year marks my last with a child at St Andrew's. I've been incredibly fortunate to be part of the St Andrew's community for the past seven years, and during that time I've made so many wonderful memories. With Kit moving on to Potters Gate in September, my time as Chair and involvement with the PTFA will also be coming to an end. It's been a genuine pleasure to help organise so many events at school, to see the fun and enjoyment of the children makes all the hard work worthwhile. St Andrew's really is a special little place.

That means we're now looking for a new Chair – or perhaps Co-Chairs – to take over leading the charity that plays such an important role in supporting our school. Under our charity constitution, we need four trustees: Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer and Secretary. These roles have to be confirmed at the AGM, which will take place at the end of September or beginning of October.

Being Chair might sound like a big commitment, but in reality there are a few key responsibilities and things that have to happen throughout the year, but the role can take as much or as little of your time as you're able to give.

Over the past few of years, we've followed a fairly consistent calendar of events, including: Welcome BBQ (September), October half-term event, Christmas Fair and Nativity refreshments, School Disco (January), Parents' Quiz Night (February), Easter activities and Sponsored Bounce (March/April) and the Spring Fair.

Alongside these, there's also the Farnham Charity Bike Ride, although that has its own dedicated team and isn't the responsibility of the core PTFA committee.

As Chair, I've been able to be involved in all of these events, but that certainly doesn't mean a new Chair would need to do the same. In fact, I'd love to see more people taking ownership of individual events, with different volunteers leading and coordinating throughout the year. We already have plans, checklists and guidance for all of our regular events, so no one would be starting from scratch.

This is also a great opportunity to bring in fresh ideas. New people bring new energy, and there are so many fun fundraising ideas out there that don't require huge amounts of time, especially when a small team works together.

If you've ever thought about getting more involved, or you're simply curious about what the Chair role involves, I'd really encourage you to get in touch. I'd be more than happy to have a chat, answer any questions, and talk honestly about what's involved – there's absolutely no obligation.
